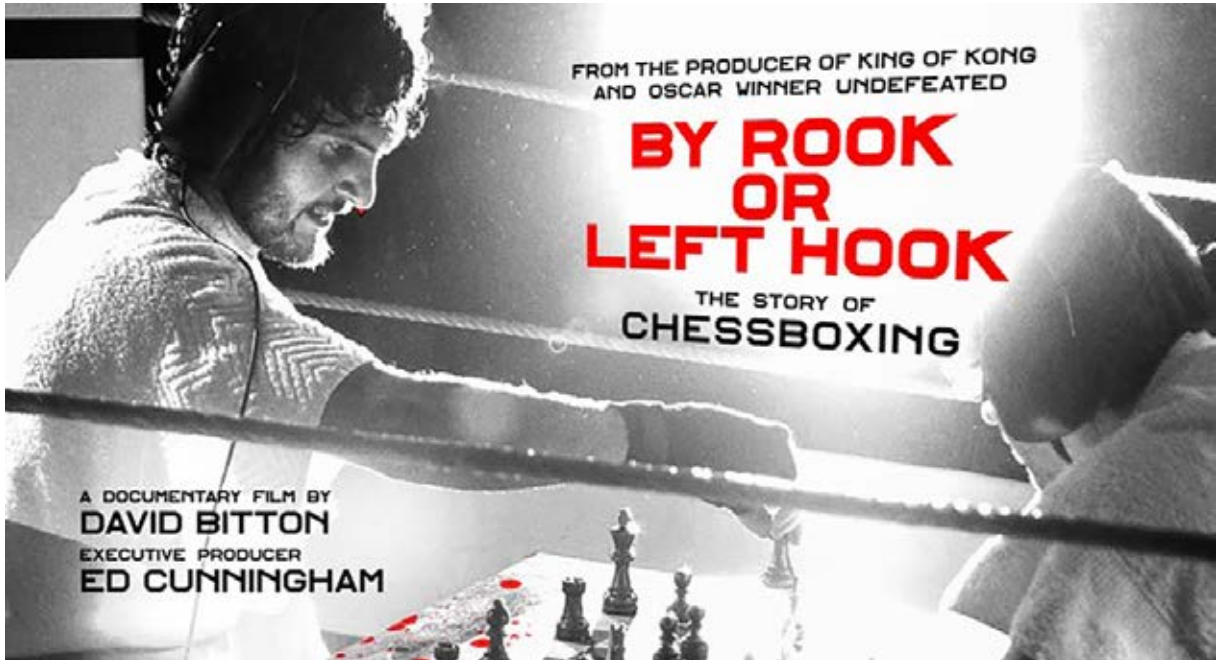

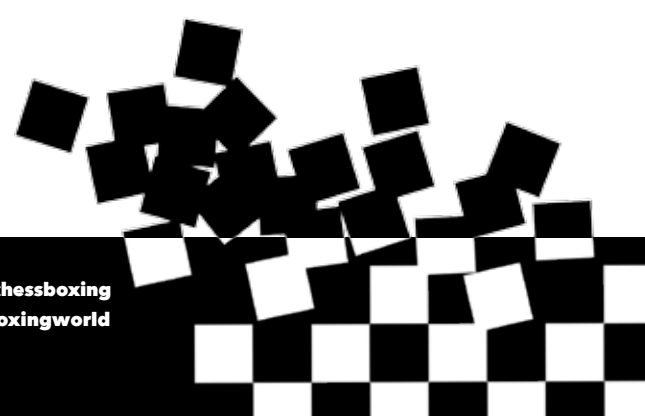

DISCOVERING SICILY

Sicily has been known for much longer as the triangular island, the three-caped island, or the Trinacria. Separated from Italy by a strait just 3.1km wide (1.9 miles) at its narrowest point, and only 140km (87 miles) from the African shore, the bulk of Sicily dominates the sea-lanes from east to west and north to south.

majority of the northern coast still retains at least some of these groves, as well as some wonderful medieval towns and castles on the hills and mountains that line the shore. The old groves around Palermo have long since given way to a concrete jungle though, which, in spite of being less easy on the eye, is still a fascinating place to explore. Geographically and culturally different from all the other regions of Sicily, the Western



At 25,708 km² (9,925.9 sq miles) including dependent islands, Sicily is the largest island in the Mediterranean, and one of the most diverse in terms of geography, flora and fauna. It is easiest to describe when divided into discrete regions:

The citrus groves of the Northern coast were so productive in the late 19th century that, for a while, the area around Palermo (the then heartland of production) became one of the most expensive pieces of real-estate in the world. The vast

coast is a calm and tranquil region: wide-open landscapes unencumbered by the mountain ranges that run through the other parts of the island; stunning sandy beaches leading to a beautifully verdant countryside; flat-roofed towns that seem more suited to North Africa than Europe. The grapes of this region are used in some of the most famous Sicilian wines (Marsala in particular), and are a great accompaniment to the wonderfully varied seafood dishes that are prepared here. The southern coast consists of



a long, nearly entirely unbroken, stretch of coastal plain framed by the mountains and foothills that lie at its back. Although natural harbours are extremely limited on this coast, some of the richest and most important

cheap competition from abroad, and a lack of enthusiasm from the newest generations to engage in such back-breaking work has taken its toll. Abandoned houses and farmsteads litter the landscape, and isolated



cities of the ancient world were located here - such as Selinunte, Agrigento, Gela and, on the south-eastern corner, Syracuse itself. None of these are large centres of population today, but the agricultural riches are still there and this region is noted for the quality of its wines, olives, fruits and (in the south-east) the flavoursome tomatoes of Pachino.

Central Sicily is, in summer, one long undulating mass of sun-scorched fields arrayed around the craggy mountains that crowd Sicily's heart. In Antiquity this was one of the major grain-producing areas that fed the city of Rome, but cereal production has dropped off markedly as depopulation,



mountain-top towns glower down on the modern roads that have passed them by.

Volcanic activity means that the height of Etna is ever-changing, rendering precise altitude figures meaningless, but it is safe to say that (at 3,300m+) it is an imposing spectacle when it hasn't wrapped itself in mist and clouds. The incredible richness of the soil here (an eventual by-product of the eruptions) has made this area one of the most agriculturally productive on the island; an abundance that is matched by the richness of the

fishing beds that are worked by the fleets of the many coastal towns. Catania is the main town of this region, and the most lively in terms of culture and nightlife on the entire island - it richly deserves its old nickname of "the Milan of the South".



PALERMO

It is a city of the south of Italy, on the northwestern coast of Sicily, on the Tyrrhenian Sea. It's the capital of Sicily, an independent region of Italy. It has 689.193 inhabitants and 158,88

square metres. Palermo has the largest port of Sicily.

In the city there are many buildings that go back to the period when Sicily was a Norman kingdom.

There are also Arab, Byzantine and Spanish influences. Palermo was founded by the Phoenicians in the 8th century BC and was a Carthaginian colony.

It was taken by the Romans in 254 BC. It subsequently passed into the hands of the Goths (AD 440), the Byzantines (535), the Saracens (831), the Normans (1072), and the Holy Roman emperors (1194). The economy isn't very good, because there are small-medium factories and unemployment is high. It is a trading centre for the island's agricultural produce and has factories

engaged in food processing, shipbuilding, and the manufacture of furniture, leather products, glass, chemicals, cement, textiles, and paper.

This a very beautiful city for its monuments, its nature as the mountains, the sea, the trees and many other things.

The most beautiful places in Palermo are the Cathedral, the Church of San Giovanni degli Eremiti, the Royal Palace with the Palatine Chapel and a lot of other places.

Near the centre of Palermo, in Saint Pellegrino Mountain, there is the sanctuary of Saint Rosalie, the patron saint of the city.

Every year, in the week of 15th July, there is a feast to celebrate the saint.

In September there is a pilgrimage from the centre of Palermo to the sanctuary in St. Pellegrino Mountain.

In this city the weather is very hot in summer, about 40°C and in Winter it is not very cold. The sea is fantastic, in fact it is one of the most beautiful attractions for foreign tourists.

BACKGROUND AND PREMISES

The purpose of the artistic project is fitting into the chessboxing game event with multiple arts exhibitions, coherently integrated both within the location and in the heart of the sporting event, to give even more power to what the message wants to convey. Chessboxing is a combined sport, which mixes boxing and chess. It was conceived by the Dutch artist Lepe Rubingh, winner of the first edition dating back to 2003, who thought of making it a structured discipline, drawing inspiration from the graphic novel "Freddo Equatore" but with a variation from the book: not a chess game and a boxing match performed one by one, but the alternation of the two activities.

So the physical static, with a strong use of the mind, of chess games and the

adrenaline and strongly bodily action of boxing matches, alternate therefore, in a continuous search for concentration and control of personal functions. So body and mind become two fundamental functions therefore that cannot be split into any of the activities that can be carried out, whether they are sports, art or everyday life.

First influences the other, so it's necessary to know how to manage both, also and above all in critical moments, where one can and must consciously become the support of the other. There is no game without strategy, there is no sport without control, there is no art if the gestures do not touch the intro specification. For the section of "Figurative Arts" was selected and involved a range of local artists who are not limited to representing the reality that surrounds them but, conceptually and stylistically reinterpret it.



ARTISTS AND SECTIONS

Personal Exhibition - Painting "The Golden Age of Burlesque"

GIANCARLO RUBINO

Giancarlo is part of the event with a personal exhibition, which has Burlesque as its theme and conductor. The artist's introspective expression operation starts from listening to Marilyn Manson's album "The Golden Age of Grotesque" and leads him to reinterpret female beauty by making fun of the very concept of making the body a spectacular object through the joke.

Personal Exhibition - Painting "Sikelia Folk - interpretation of a Sicilian dream"

EUGENIA AFFRONTI

Eugenia draws on the various typical symbols of Sicilian folklore and reworking them makes them an introspective work. Through the pictorial representation of paladins, cannoli, cassate cakes, fichi d'India, she expresses herself, using a language rich in allegiance that distances her art from the concept of folklore to itself and enriches it with a strong surrealist connotation.

Collective Exhibition - Painting "Pictorial gesture and introspective control"

In this collective exhibition, four artists are gathered who play with corporeality and make abstraction, not pure figurative or portrait painting, but reworked bodies in order to express emotional concepts and interiorities, carrying out an operation with conceptual that manages to transform something intangible into tangible expression on the canvas.

Personal Exhibition - Sculpture "Hands that shape the stone and the thoughts"

SALVATORE VALENTI

It is through the working of the stone that Salvatore expresses memories and emotions united by a strong reference to his homeland. The gesture molds the hard stone into personal expressive forms of fantastic, grotesque, sometimes su surprising faces, characterized by an anthropomorphic stylistic language, managing, through the conceptual binomial sky/Earth, which gives body to his most personal memories and to universal values as in a cry for liberation.

GUIDED TOUR TO ERICE AND TRAPANI PROGRAMME 9TH DECEMBER FROM 8:30 TO 13:30

Erice is the medieval village overlooking Trapani - seat of the Ettore Majorana scientific research center - located at 751 meters above sea level and the temperature, even in the height of

summer, is several degrees lower than the coast.

Sunny and luminous Erice on hot summer days, when light floods the narrow streets and wonderful views open into the valley and the sea, and on winter days when, shrouded in clouds, the town seems to rejoin its mythical roots and gives the traveler the feeling tranquility and well-being, it seems to have arrived in a place out of time and reality. The medieval atmosphere, the fresh air, the beautiful pine forests that surround it, the tranquility that reigns there and the local craftsmanship make it one of the favorite destinations for tourists. Erice is rich in history and traditions that still persist over the centuries; there are the peculiarities of the medieval town, making it unique in its kind. A real place of peace, enriched by breathtaking views, which extend from the western hinterland of Sicily, up to the suggestive Egadi Islands. Erice is characteristic of the tasty and nice sweets, the Ericini. A history of gastronomy and cultural tradition that was born thanks to the expert hands of the nuns of the Monaster.

TRAPANI is the city of salt and sailing and an excellent starting point for many beautiful destinations in Western Sicily. The visit will take you to discover one of the most evocative cities in Sicily. City of a thousand facets, known

for its precious jewelery, where silver is accompanied by the red of coral, Trapani is today a lively city, an ideal tourist destination for those who want to combine sport, trekking, diving but also a holiday dedicated to good local food and wine. Here there is a succession of historic buildings and churches of considerable artistic value such as the Cathedral, Palazzo Riccio di

Morana, the Church of Purgatory, with the twenty Sacred Groups of the Mysteries that characterize the Good Friday procession. On Corso Vittorio Emanuele we will also see the the Cathedral of San Lorenzo, the Torre Oscura and the Clock Tower, the Palazzo Senatorio and, behind it, the fourteenth-century Church of Sant'Agostino, with its façade embellished with a rose window and the fountain of Saturn, once the protector of Trapani.



ATTENTION In the event that for any reason one of the monuments should not be open to visitors, we will proceed, on the recommendation of the Tourist

Guide, to a visit to a monument or other alternative place. All participants in the excursion will receive a souvenir gadget. The trip will take place with a minimum participation of 50 people per coach.

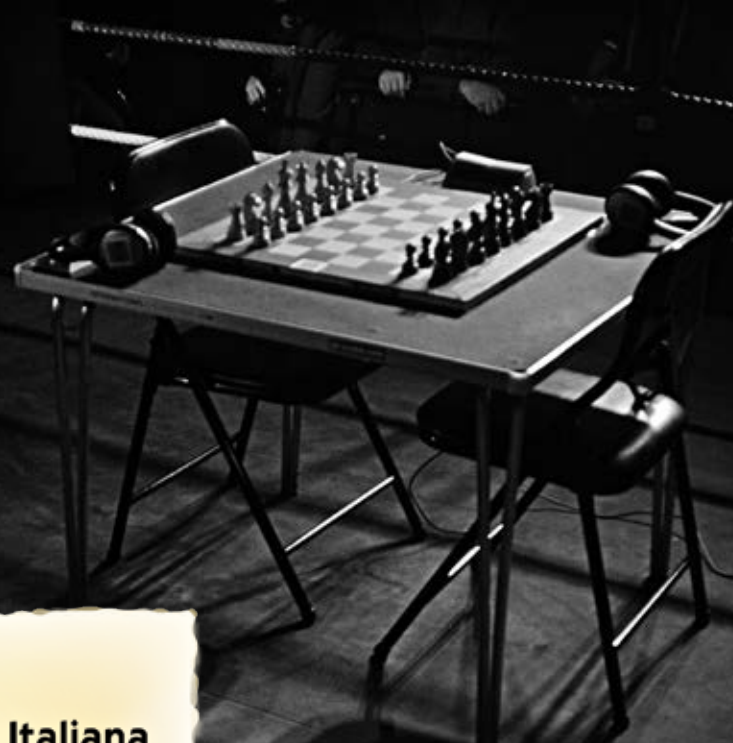
